



Games Day 4-The Compliment Game

Today, we learned that we can LIVE for God by loving others. Jesus said the most important thing we can do is love others. Loving others means loving people who are different than us. Loving others also means loving people close to us, even though we all know that can be hard at times. In the spirit of loving others, we're going to play the compliment game!

Optional Supplies:

Paper

Pen, pencil, or marker

A stuffed animal or something to hold that shows who is being complimented or to show who is talking

What you do:

Sit in a circle. Choose one person to start. Everyone in your family must say at least one compliment about this person. Remember to say thank you when you are complimented. Then choose a few people your family can complement together. Maybe think of someone who is different than you, someone who speaks a different language, someone who you want to know Jesus. Go around the circle and share compliments about them. If you want, someone can write down those compliments to share or save for later when you need some encouragement.

Ask your child(ren) how the compliments made them feel? Then remind them that Jesus wants us to love everyone!
